Scratching the surface – diving in deep, part 2

On September 3rd, 2008 artist Jooyoung Lee invited DJ Eugene Blake and migrant worker Minod Moktan to meet at Yogiga, a gallery space in Hongdae, Seoul, South Korea. This was the initial meeting to set up a collaboration resulting in Lee's contribution to the *Independent Drawing Gig* (LINK: http://www.gigaction.com) at Jinyoung Plastic Factory in Incheon.Throughout several sessions during the autumn, DJ Eugene Blake taught Moktan techniques for being a DJ.

Scratching the surface – diving in deep, part 2 is a direct response to the specific location of the factory: Incheon, a seaport city west of Seoul. In 2003 Incheon Free Economic Zone (IFEZ) was created with the aim to encourage international commerce and business, also by making it an English speaking city. This area and South Korea in general has a large population of migrant workers, who in reality continue to have limited protection against discrimination and abuse in spite of Korea being the first labour importing country in Asia to seek to protect their rights by passing the Act Concerning the Employment Permit for Migrant Workers (EPS Act) in 2004.

The Jinyoung Plastic factory was still producing their products during the event of the *Independent Drawing Gig* Lee invited Moktan to make a DJ-set for the closing of the exhibition, and thus act as a music ambassador playing different music, also the music selected for the previous edition of *Scratching the surface – diving in deep, part 1* in Bergen, Norway to the art crowd and the workers.

Part two happened in Seoul from September to November 2008. The third part will take place in Morocco during the autumn 2009. Each part of *Scratching the surface – diving in deep* is an auditive response to each of the locations of the project consisting of sound/music and interviews.
